Items which should be brought to camp:

Uniform. (Is not needed at Camp). But if you have a Torksey Camp T-Shirt from another year you could wear that if you want.

Shoes or trainers suitable for games and walking.

A complete change of clothing.

Sports kit or play clothing.

TOWEL & Toiletries.

Nightwear.

Rainwear.

Sleeping bag and **PILLOW**, or two sheets and a **PILLOW** (two blankets are on each bed).

Small indoor game or book.

A Biro and pencil.

Labelled purse or bum bag.

A plastic carrier bag for wet or muddy shoes or clothing.

MEDICATION / MEDICAL FORM, to be given to

ALL CLOTHING SHOULD BE LABELLED WITH OWNER'S NAME.

PORTABLE TELEVISIONS, RADIOS, MP3 & IPOD PLAYERS (**or mobile telephones**), GLASS BOTTLES, TORCHES, FOOTBALLS, ALCOHOL, KNIVES OF ANY DESCRIPTION SHOULD **NOT** BE BROUGHT TO CAMP.

No one is allowed to leave the Camp without the Camp Adjutant's permission.

Spending Money - for the Tuck Shop, Saturday off site visit and the Sunday service Collection, not to exceed £5.00 on grounds of security and in small change if possible.

Behaviour: Parents are reminded this event is very much a team event and Boys/Girls are encouraged to develop and care for one another in a happy holiday environment. In the unfortunate circumstance any child misbehaves beyond normal high spirits you will be contacted and asked to come and collect them. Officers suggest you remind your child before they leave home and advise them this includes going into other rooms without permission.
